

## **NESTLE BOYCOTT POLICY**

## PROBLEM/IDEA

Nestle products were previously sold within Heriot Watt University Student Union. As a result of the first version of this policy several years ago, they are no longer sold at any Union outlet, however are continuing to be sold from other on-campus outlets.

This policy has been in place for several years and as of April 2024 the reasons for the policy shows no sign of slowing.

The Nestlé Corporation is the subject to many ongoing boycotts as of 04/2024;

- 1) Baby Milk for Action (IBFAN) (The worlds longest running boycott)
- 2) Lakota People's Law Project
- 3) <u>Many other smaller calls</u> to boycott due to many ongoing <u>scandals</u>

The Nestlé corporation are widely known for their <u>immoral</u> and <u>unethical</u> practises across the globe. Issues including:

- Workers' rights
- Exploiting farmers
- Union busting
- Human rights
- Extremely unethical business practise
- Unethical marketing of artificial baby milk
- Fraudulent labelling
- The Ethiopia scandal
- Severe environmental concerns
- Illegal extraction of groundwater
- Pollution
- Violations of Fair Trade

As a result some universities, colleges and schools have banned the sale of Nestlé products from their shops and vending machines in the period since the revelations.
